In the A2 German courses in Berlin you will understand sentences and repeated expressions related to areas of very immediate importance (e.g. information about a person and family, shopping). You can communicate in simple situations (e.g. the direct exchange of information about familiar and everyday life). How long does it take to learn German A2? A2: approx. 150 hours of lessons. B1: 300 hours of lessons. B2: 240 hours of lessons. What is A2 in German? The Goethe-Zertifikat A2 is a German exam for adults. It requires elementary language skills and corresponds to the second level (A2) on the six-level scale of competence laid down in the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR). Is A2 German enough? Is A2 German proficiency enough for an international student there? ... A2 level is not sufficient to pursue any course offered in German in Germany. Can I learn German in 2 years? Those who dedicate at least one hour per day to language learning can achieve an intermediate level within two years.
